

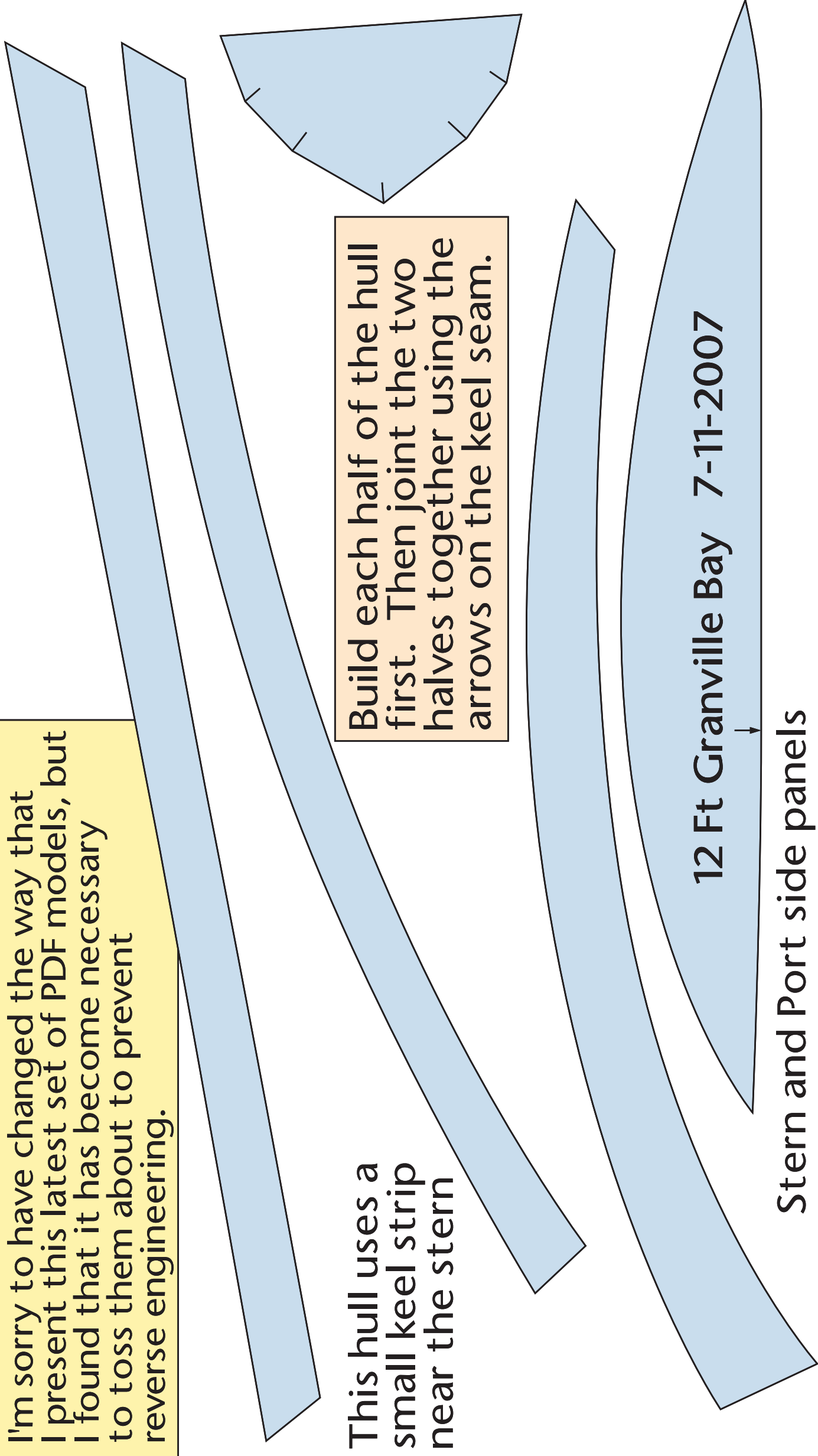
I'm sorry to have changed the way that I present this latest set of PDF models, but I found that it has become necessary to toss them about to prevent reverse engineering.

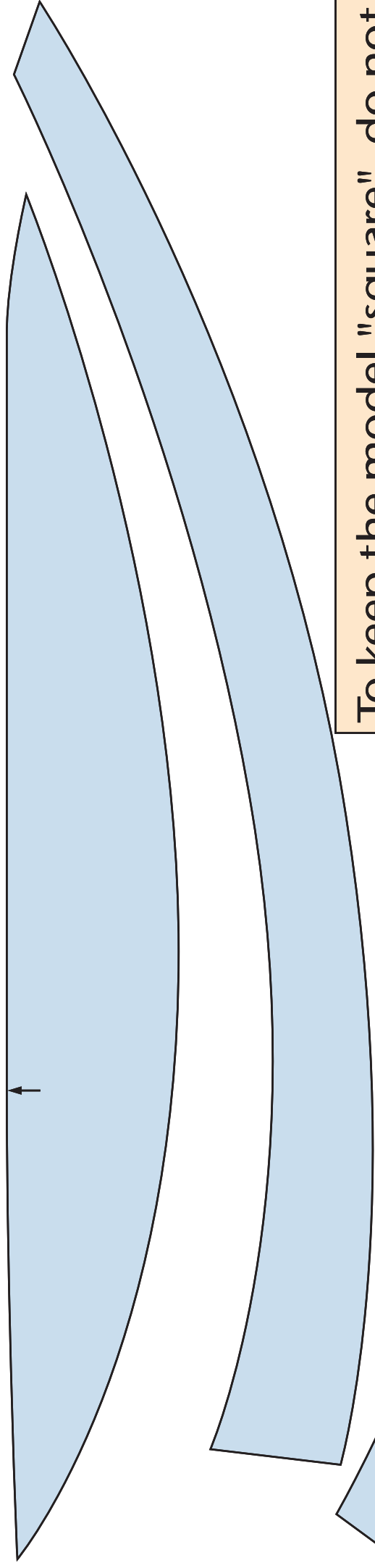
This hull uses a small keel strip near the stern

Build each half of the hull first. Then joint the two halves together using the arrows on the keel seam.

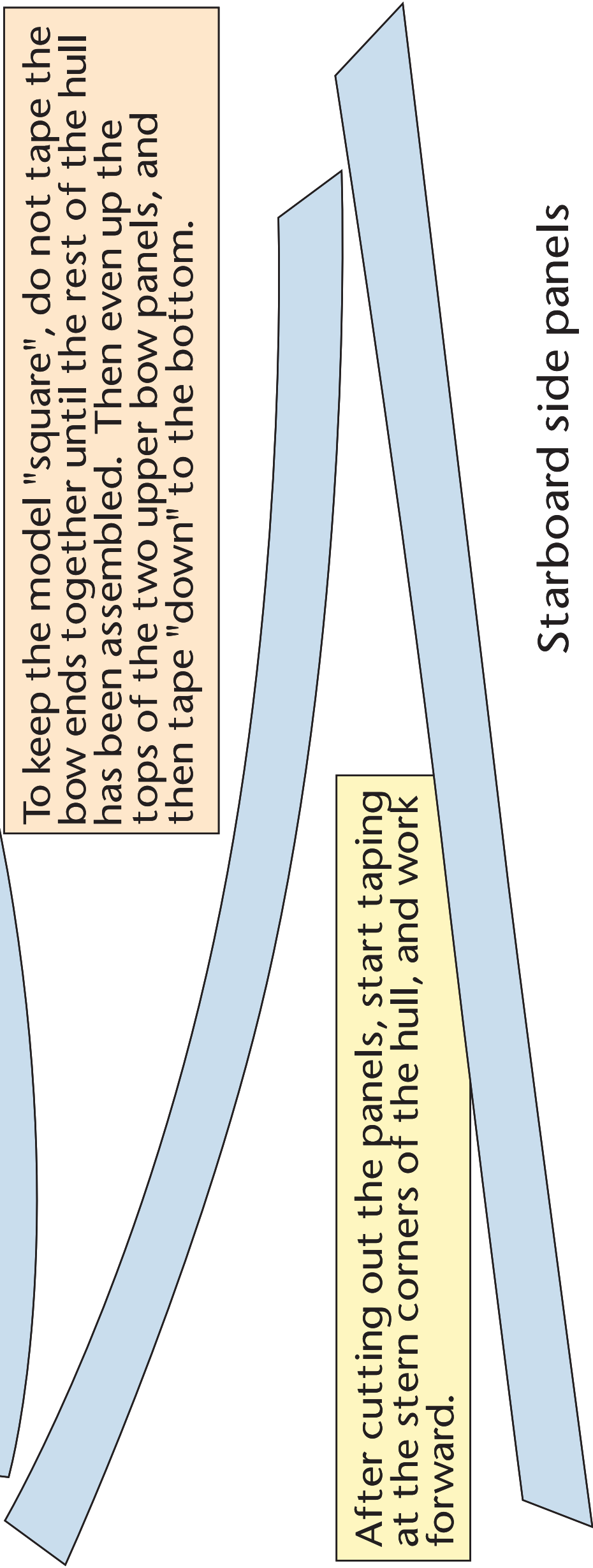
Stern and Port side panels





To keep the model "square", do not tape the bow ends together until the rest of the hull has been assembled. Then even up the tops of the two upper bow panels, and then tape "down" to the bottom.

After cutting out the panels, start taping at the stern corners of the hull, and work forward.



Starboard side panels
